### **Scholarships & Awards**

- Tuition and fees for an eligible master's or professional degree at McGill
- A living stipend of \$2,000 per month during academic terms
- A one-time relocation grant for moving to Montréal
- Summer funding options

### Selection Criteria

When selecting McCall MacBain Scholars, our committees look for evidence of:

Exceptional character
Community engagement
Leadership potential
Entrepreneurial spirit
Academic strength
Intellectual curiosity

## **Eligibility**

You must meet ONE of the following criteria:

- You are a current student on track to earn your first bachelor's degree
- You earned your first bachelor's degree in the last five years
- You earned your first bachelor's degree more than five years ago, and are 30 years or younger in the calendar year that you apply

You will also need to meet the minimum requirements for McGill master's program admission, as well as requirements for your program(s) of choice.

### **Application Process**

The McCall MacBain Scholarship application is separate from and earlier than McGill graduate admissions. After applying for the scholarship, applicants should apply directly to McGill programs.

More than 250 semi-finalists will be invited to regional interviews, either in-person (for Canadians) or online. Afterwards, up to 85 finalists will be invited to Montréal for final interviews. Thirty McCall MacBain Scholars (20 Canadians, 10 international students) will be selected each year.




#### **TIMELINE**

Rated as one of North America's most affordable cities, Montréal allows students to enjoy a high quality of life while accessing job opportunities in different economic sectors.






### **McGill University**


### **SCHOLARS**

Meet two students in our 2023 cohort:

#### Agnès Totschnig MSc, Mathematics and Statistics Montréal, Québec

Agnès completed her bachelor's degree in mathematics and computer science at McGill. During her studies, she led a team to organize the university's largest



annual hackathon and started a similar event in Nigeria. Agnès co-founded the diversity in the math club and participated in the equity, outreach, and student well-being committee.



**Mohit Kumar** MA, Educational Leadership Firozabad, India

Mohit graduated from Ashoka University, studying history, international relations, and Persian. Since 2019, he has been working to improve literacy in his community

through Sarathi: The Guide. His project has expanded to mobilize 45 volunteers to support 850 students in 10 villages. Mohit also worked as a residence assistant mentor, held several other jobs, and volunteered as a peer tutor.



Funded in perpetuity, the McCall MacBain Scholarships are the result of a \$200-million gift by John and Marcy McCall MacBain and their Foundation in 2019. At the time, it was the largest single donation in Canadian history.
