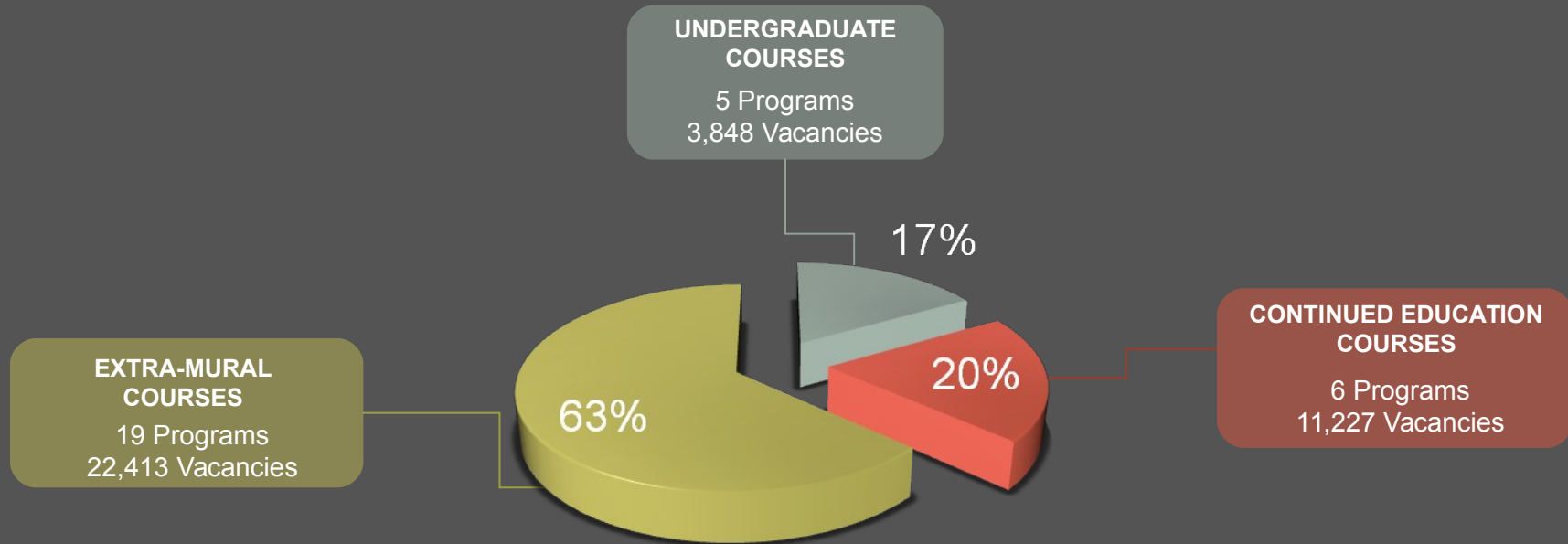

A technological park that hosts companies committed to investigating and producing new technologies in both public and private centers of research and development.

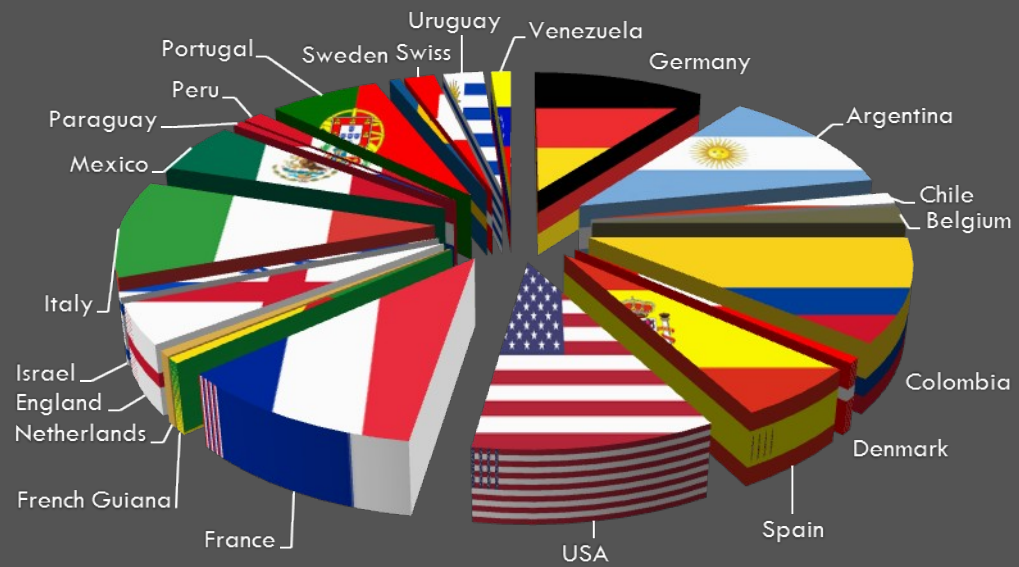

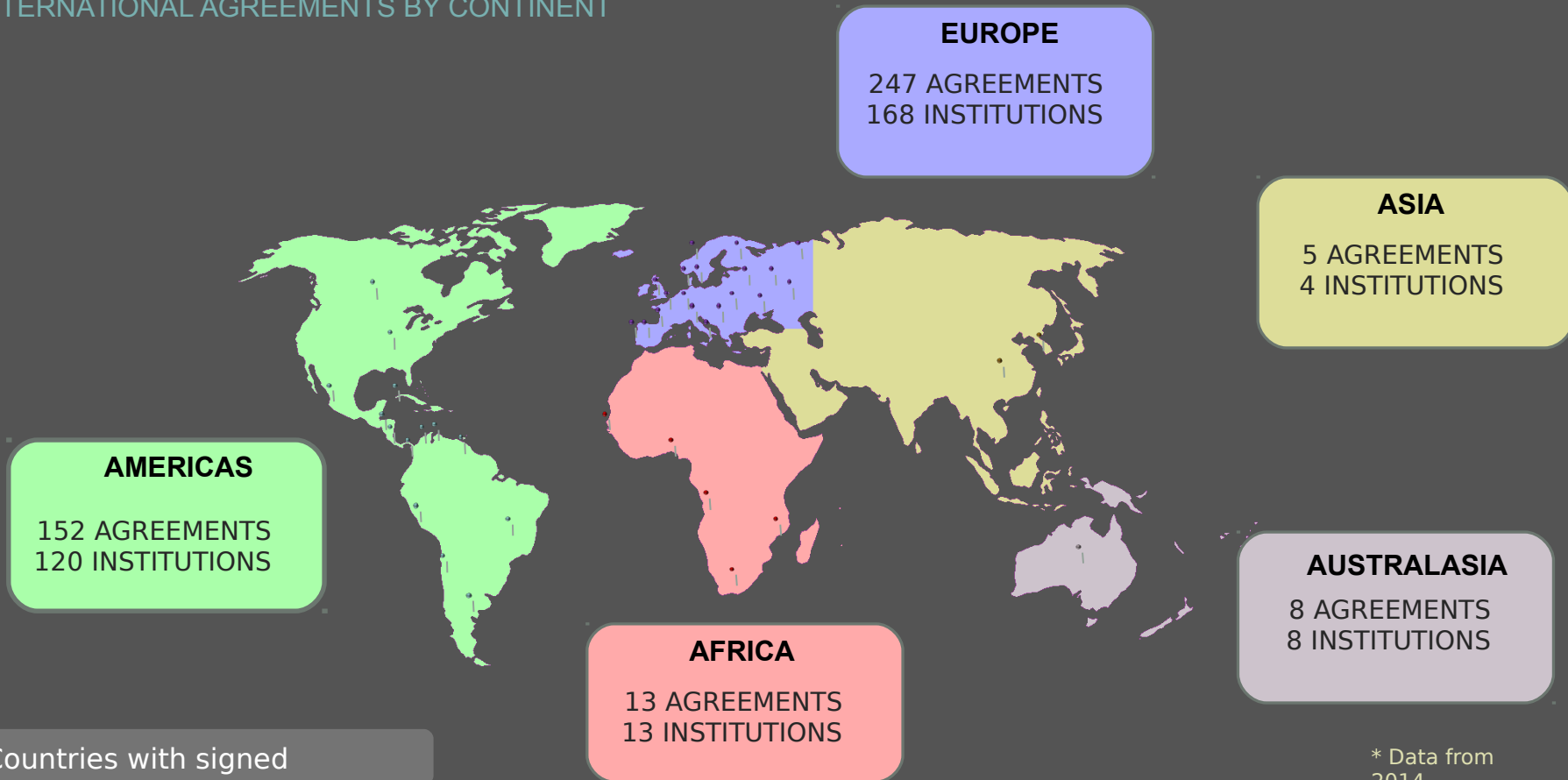

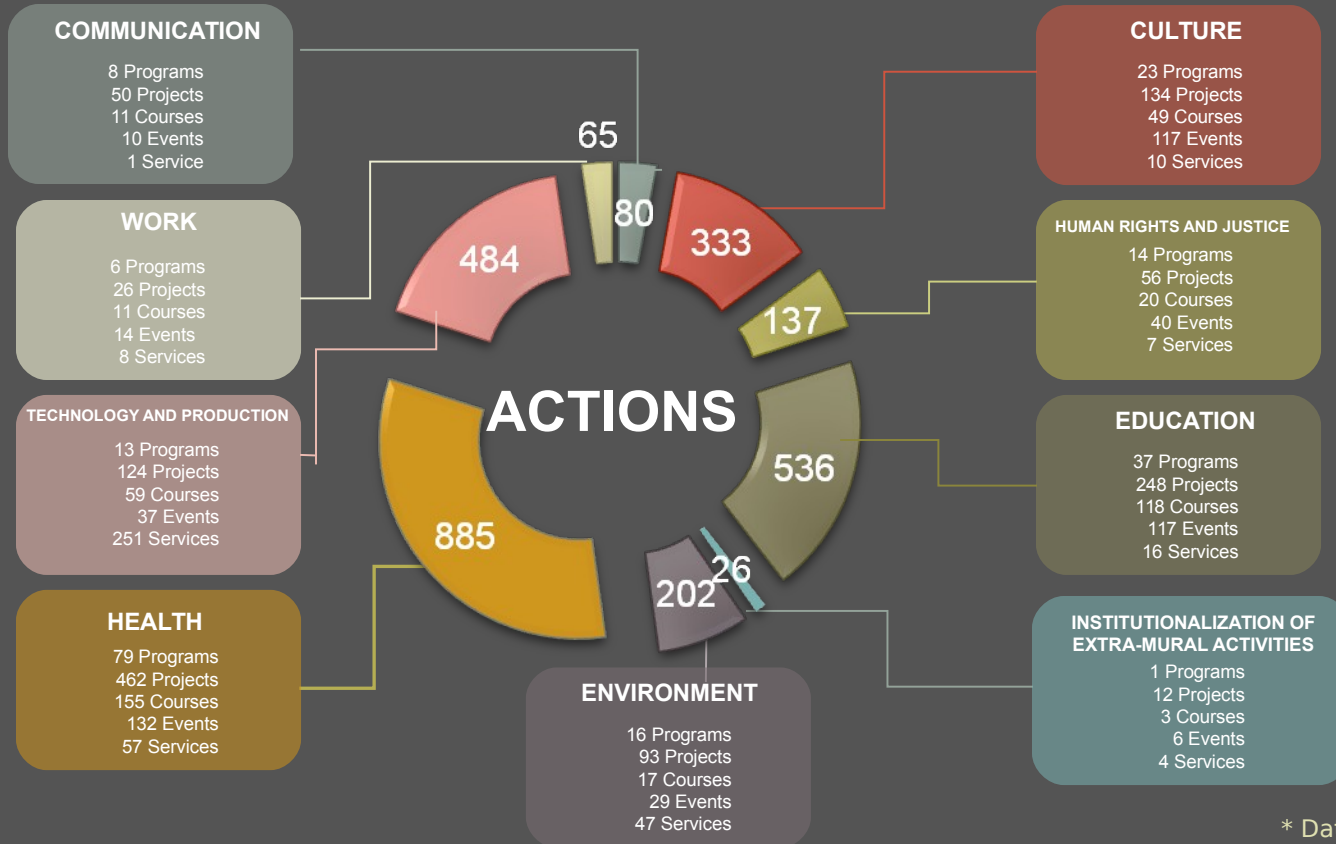

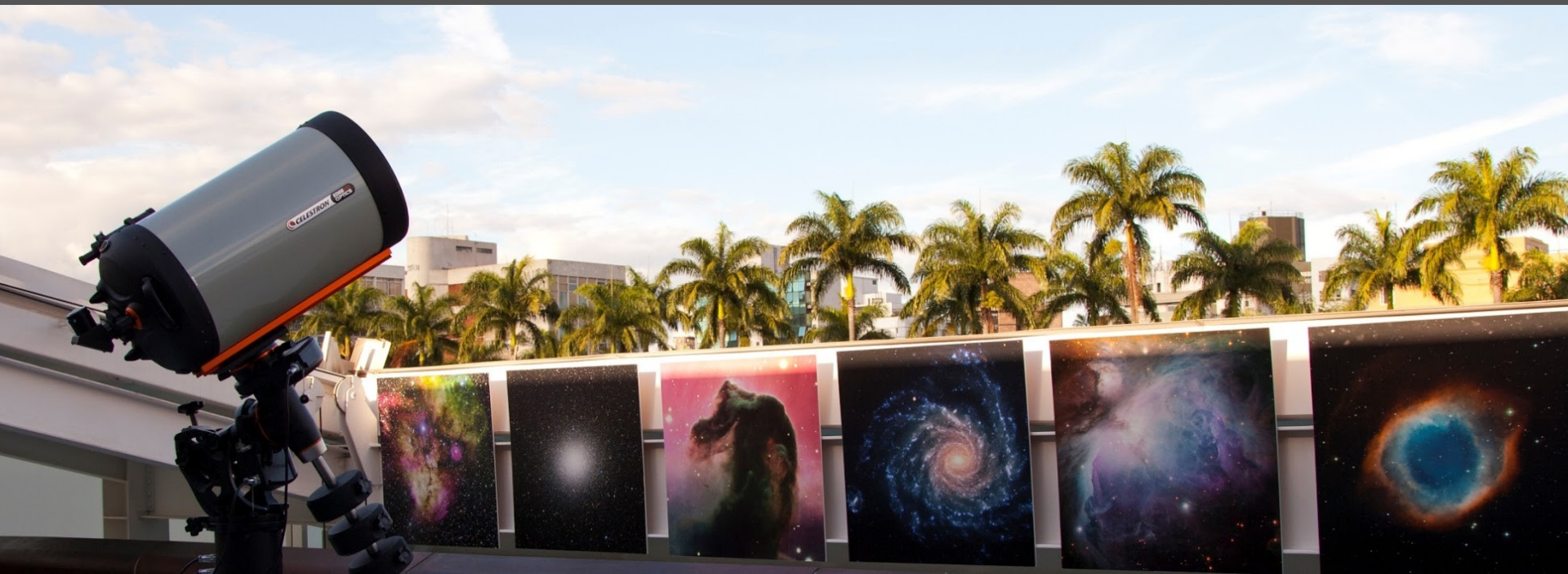
The exterior façade of the UFMG Museum of Knowledge is constructed with a special vitreous material, which transforms the building into a projection screen

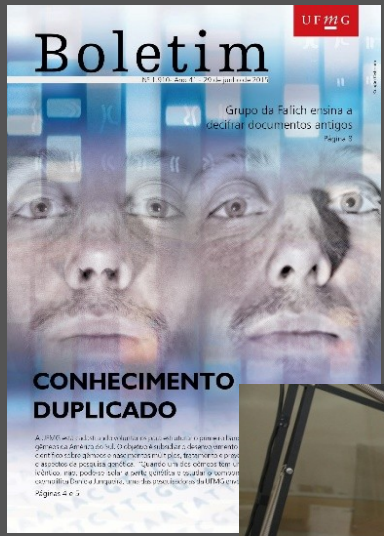
